I'm all for it and would buy the realtime upgrade if TS could interface with QuoteTracker and or IB directly. I love the charting capabilities of QT and you certainly can't beat the price. I was a bit worried when TD Ameritrade bought QuoteTracker out but it seems as if the program will continue on as before. I would be most interested in TS being able to backfill and download historical data thru the QT API.

The nice thing about interfacing with QuoteTracker is that it has the capability to connect to a number of different brokers and data centers. See here for all the different sources QT can use. (it can even use eSignal). <http://www.quotetracker.com/qsources.shtml> If TS can interface to QT, it's actually interfacing with a multitude of places.

So, ... count me as a yes vote.

on behalf of Sergey, I would like to rise a question-inquiry to all of you about another data-feeding API (similar to eSignal) which, in my opinion, is a more reliable and definitely a lot cheaper product.

This tool is called QuoteTracker <http://www.quotetracker.com/>

There is an introduction to it:

QuoteTracker is a Windows program that integrates with various datafeeds, brokers and financial sites to provide you with streaming real-time quotes, Live intraday charts with Technical Indicators, Level II quotes, Time and Sales, alerts, news monitoring, and everything else you may need to trade in today's market.

It also ties into major brokers to give you full Integrated trading from within the software. You can trade through your own broker using **QuoteTracker** interface. Order Entry and transaction monitoring is fast and streamlined. **Cannot beat the price - it's FREE!**

QuoteTracker can be used to track most types of securities - **Stocks, Options, Indices, Futures, FOREX/Currencies, Bonds, etc**

So, to compare it to the eSignal, you can have the same data steaming from most of the well-known brokers (including eSignal) for free, which can save you a significant amount of money on very expensive eSignal subscription.

Sergey said that he can inbuilt the QuoteTracker's API into TS (through the same way as eSignal, as add-on) but only, if there will be a "significant" amount of interest in that.

That's why I'm encouraging you to give your vote on this inquiry.
